Codacide Oil is an agricultural adjuvant based on the emulsion technology. It is a 95% natural vegetable oil adjuvant formulated with a series of plant based emulsifiers.

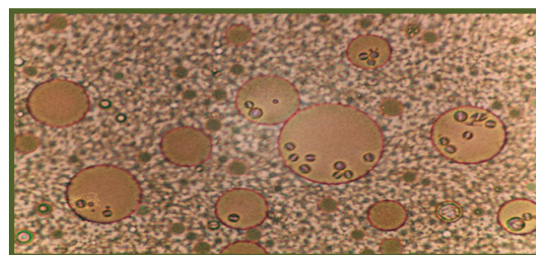
Product Features :

- Improves deposition, adhesion, spread and uptake of chemicals to the target,

Codacide Oil is currently registered in 13 countries: Australia, Cyprus, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands, New Zealand, Romania, Portugal, Saudi Arabia, Spain, UK.

Mode of Action:

When pre-mixed with a pesticide, the emulsifiers latch onto the product, forming a shell of oil around each pesticide molecule. When this complex is added to water in the spray tank, a 'controlled emulsion' is formed. It is this encapsulation that is the key to Codacide oil's unique efficiency as a carrier of the plant protection products.

Direction for Use:

Dosage : 1.2 to 1.5 Litres / hectare

Always pre-mixed with the pesticide before adding to water in the spray tank.
