

Fusarium Wilt

Fusarium wilt is caused by *fusarium spp.*

Favourable Conditions for Development of Disease

- Warm climate
- The pathogen is soil-borne and persists in the soil for several years in absent of hosts.

Hosts: Tomatoes, Potato, Banana, Beans, Cucurbits, Cole Crops

Symptoms

- Fusarium starts with a strong yellowing of the leaves followed by a wilting appearance.
- Chlorosis, necrosis, premature leaf drop, stunted growth and damping off may also occur.

Treatments:

- **Topsin M ULV**
